



## **Mobile Bar Facilities 2012**

**1. Sale or return drinks** - We can provide sale or return drinks. This would mean that you would be provided with and quoted for the drinks and quantity that you want and would be invoiced after your function for the actual drinks consumed. This does not include service of drinks or bar facilities. It does include the necessary glassware and chilled drinks where necessary. Please note that once a bottle has been opened it will be charged for and at least 50% of the amount quoted for must be paid for. Please see sale or return menu for prices and options. Staff can also be hired to serve these drinks. See point 5.

**2. Cash bar (Dry Bar)** - You can pay for a cash bar. This is at a cost of £125. This means that you would be provided with full bar facilities. We can also provide a cocktail bar facility for an additional £75 for which you can choose up to five cocktails to add onto your bar menu (please refer to our cocktail list for options). The cash bar includes a mobile bar which would be set up by our staff, all glassware, drinks and fully trained bartenders to serve. Your guests can pay for their drinks as normal just the same as in a normal bar. The cash bar will stock a good supply and range of wines, beers, lagers, ciders, spirits, mixers and soft drinks. We can supply specific products upon request in advance if there are specific items that you would prefer added. The cash bar must be provided for a minimum of four hours. 6ft Bar frontage included (photos available).

**3. Part paid bar (Wet Bar)** - You may wish to have all the facilities of a cash bar as above but want to part pay for the drinks yourself. This is possible. You would agree an amount with us prior to the function and when that agreed amount has been spent, the bar would go back to being a cash bar.

**4. Unlimited bar (Wet Bar)** - You may wish to have an unlimited bar where all the same facilities are provided as the cash bar but you pay for all of the drinks consumed on the night. Please note that a non refundable deposit of £750 is required for this facility (£125 of which is for the bar and £625 of which would be deducted from the final invoice.) Any additional funds owed must be settled on the night of the function.

**5. Bar staff and service** - You can provide the drinks yourself or use the sale or return (option 1) and just hire bar staff to serve drinks and cocktails. Our bar staff can be hired at a cost of £14.50 per hour as above or cocktail bartenders at £17.00 per hour. Staff are hired for a minimum of four hours including one hours travel. If you require cocktail bartenders, they can bring all of their own cocktail making equipment for a cost of £50.00.

**6. Service charge** - If you are already using our staff to assist with food service, but are providing your own drinks, there would be a service/cover charge of £1.50 per person for any drinks service.

**7. Coolers/ice** - Bags of ice can be provided for a cost of £2 per 1kg bag. Drinks coolers to keep large amounts of drinks cold may be hired for a cost of £15 each. We can also help organise larger chiller trailers from one of our suppliers if required.

**8. Glassware hire** - Glassware may be hired at a cost of £10 per case of 24 glasses. Specialist glasses can also be quoted for. Breakages will be charged for. Disposable glassware can also be purchased. Please ask a member of our team for a quote.

**9. Bar frontage** - 6ft Bar frontage available for hire. Photos available upon request. £95+VAT.

**11. Collection** - A collection service of £50 can be provided. This is when staff are due to finish at a certain time but you require the glassware to be left at your function and then collected the following day.

### **Important information regarding provision of drinks by Total Hospitality**

Please note that if you choose for Total Hospitality Ltd to provide the drinks at your function (options 1, 2, 3 & 4), then no other drinks may be provided by yourselves or your guests unless a special agreement has been made with us in advance. If we are supplying a cash bar, we reserve the right to stop service if guests are sourcing their drinks and supply of drinks from elsewhere as this would put us in breach of our license. All normal licensing laws apply and under no circumstances are underage drinkers to be served or guests whom the staff deem to have had enough to drink to be served. The bar must allow 30 minutes drinking up time after the bar has closed and then all drinks will be removed from the guests and venue. Total Hospitality Ltd carries its own personal, portable license, but if a venue is being used, the venue must also have a license. If it does not have one in place, an temporary event notice (TEN) can be applied for by the venue hirers through the local council. The cost for this is around £21. We would need a copy of the TEN 14 days prior to the event. Private venues or houses do not require any other license other than the Total Hospitality personal, portable license.
